

## **András Szöllősi-Nagy**

Professor Szöllősi-Nagy was born in Budapest, Hungary. He holds a *Dipl. Ing.* in Civil Engineering (1972), a *Dr. Techn.* in Hydrology and Mathematical Statistics (1975) from the Budapest University of Technology (BME) and a *Ph.D.* in hydrology from the same university. He earned the *Doctor of Science (D.Sc.)* degree from the Hungarian Academy of Sciences in 1991. In the same year, he was awarded *Dr. Habil.* by the Budapest University of Technology. In 1994 he became full Professor at the same institution. From 1989 until 2009 he served as Secretary of UNESCO's International Hydrological Programme. In 2009 he was nominated Professor of Stochastic Hydrology both at UNESCO-IHE and TU Delft. Between 2009 and 2014 he served as Rector of the UNESCO-IHE Institute for Water Education, Delft, The Netherlands. He was Visiting Professor at the *University of Luleå*, Sweden and a regular visiting research professor at the Systems Department of the *University of Waterloo*, Waterloo, Canada. Between 2009 and 2014 he was visiting professor at the *Beijing Normal University* in Beijing, China. He was the co- (founding) Editor of the *International Journal of Stochastic Hydrology and Hydraulics*.
