She is the author of 10+ publications on water governance and the founder of the OECD Water Governance Initiative, an international network of 100+ policymakers and stakeholders gathering twice a year in a Policy Forum. Aziza Akhmouch also spearheaded the OECD Principles on Water Governance adopted by Ministers in June 2015, which set standards for effective, efficient and inclusive water policies.
