

Jerome Delli Priscoli

Dr Delli Priscoli is Chair of the Global Water Partnership (GWP) Technical Committee. For over 20 years he has been senior advisor USACE at the Institute for Water Resources. He is also lecturer at Johns Hopkins University (SAIS) in Washington. For 30 years he has designed and run social assessment, public participation and conflict resolution research and training programs along with U.S. national water policy and projects studies. Dr Delli Priscoli is a skilled mediator and facilitator and has worked throughout the world. He served on the Board of Governors and the Executive Bureau of the World Water Council and works with, and has helped found several other world associations such as the International Association for Public Participation, the World Water Council and the Global Water Partnership. Dr Delli Priscoli has been advisor to the World Bank on water policy and to all of the UN water related agencies and IFI's on water policy issues. Dr. Delli Priscoli works closely with many of the Water Ministers throughout the world. He was an original member of the U.S. delegation to the Middle East multilateral peace talks on water. He co-chaired the DG of UNESCO's world commission on Water and Freshwater Ethics. He is author of many articles and books including *Water and Civilization*, UNESCO, and *Transforming Water Conflicts*, Cambridge U Press and recent special Issues of Water Policy, the *Role of Ethics in Globalization of Water and Food* and *Case Studies of Water Related Disasters*. He is a commentator on media shows, sought after lecturer on water issues and is the Editor in Chief of the peer reviewed journal *Water Policy*. He has played pivotal roles and facilitated many of the dialogs among diplomats, senior political leaders and NGOs in each of the 7 World water forums and in most of the critical key water resources policy meetings over the last 20 years from the Dublin Principles to today. He was on the international steering committees and the political committees for the WWF's in Kyoto, Mexico City, Istanbul, Marseilles, and Daegu, Korea. Dr. Delli Priscoli has facilitated many US national water policy dialogs. He has also taught at Princeton, MIT and other major universities. The American Water Resources Association awarded him the Icko Iben award for achievement in cross disciplinary communications in water. He holds degrees in economics and political science and post doctoral studies in theological studies from Tufts and Georgetown Universities.
