

Robert Varady

Robert G. Varady is interim director and research professor of environmental policy at the Udall Center for Studies in Public Policy at the University of Arizona. He is also adjunct professor of Hydrology and Water Resources and research professor of Arid Lands Studies in the School of Natural Resources and the Environment. Varady obtained his Ph.D. in 1981 in modern history from the University of Arizona, and holds B.S. and M.S. degrees in mathematics from the City College of New York and the Polytechnic Institute of NYU, respectively. He has examined environmental and water-management policy in arid regions—with a transboundary emphasis. Varady has more than 125 publications on environmental policy and is past president of the International Water History Association (IWHA) and regular consultant to UNESCO's International Hydrological Programme.
